

Celebrity Turds™ Rules of Play

Objective - To gain the most movie points by the end of the game.

Set up - Separate the movie and celebrity cards and shuffle each deck. Each player is dealt 9 celebrity cards. Turn over a number of movie cards equal to the number of people playing e.g. 4 cards are used for four players. Place the movie cards face up in the center of the table.

How to play - Each person takes turns to play a poker hand consisting of 3 celebrity cards. Possible hands and their rank are shown on the four reference cards included with the game. The youngest person plays their 3 celebrity cards first. Play continues to the left until all players have put down their 3 cards. Each player states what hand they have as they put their cards down.

The highest ranking poker hand wins the movie with the highest points on the card. The second ranking poker hand wins the movie with the second highest points and so on. Each player claims their respective movie card and places it FACE DOWN in

front of them. Create a discard pile for your used celebrity cards.

The game now moves to round 2. Each player takes ONE new celebrity card bringing the total in their hand to 7. The player with the best poker hand in the previous round begins each new round. Play continues for a total of four rounds.

Make sure you take a new celebrity card at the start of rounds 2, 3 and 4 bringing the total number of cards in your hand to 7, 5 and 3 respectively. When you've used up all your celebrity cards in the last round each player should have four movie cards.

Shuffle the celebrity cards and repeat the process of four rounds making a total of 8 rounds. Keep all the movie cards you have won concealed for the whole game. At the end of the game each player should have 8 movie cards. Each player takes turns to add up the points on their movie cards and announces their score. The player with the highest total is the winner. In the event of a tie cut the deck. Highest card wins.

Tip: There are a lot less high value movies than lower value movies. The range is 5 to 100 going up in steps of 5. If the movie points in a round are similar or the same it may be wise to hold on to your best cards.

Determining the winning poker hand

When 2 or more people play the same type of poker hand the values on the celebrity cards dictate who wins the higher value movie. For example, 2 people play a straight. One plays 3-4-5 and the other plays 5-6-7. The straight of 5-6-7 wins. When 2 people play the same value pair the value of the third card determines the winner e.g. a pair of 10s with a 5 beats a pair of 10s with a 2. If 2 players have an identical value hand they must cut the deck to determine the winner. The player who reveals the highest card when cutting the deck wins.

Jokers - Jokers are used to represent any celebrity card you choose. If two hands are identical but one hand is using a Joker the hand without the Joker wins.

The Super Pooper - The Super Pooper is the highest hand you can have in Celebrity Turds. It consists of three cards of the same suit and the same number e.g. three 5s of Splats. Jokers are not allowed in the Super Pooper.

For a longer game - Instead of repeating the four rounds twice repeat them 3 or more times. Each phase of four rounds yields four movie cards and lasts between 10 and 15 minutes.
